


- 1. See attached Minutes of Pre-Bid Meeting held June 19, 2024 (4 Pages).

- 2. Drawing A0.1 and A1.1, dated 2-21-2024; Change Layout for MEN 105 And WOMEN 106 as follows keeping the wall adjacent to the existing toilets. Adjust Plumbing Layout as required.

- 3. Exterior Insulation requirements:
 - a. Change all exterior Wall Insulation requirements noted to drawings to "R-25 minimum with U=0.094 maximum".
 - b. Change all Roof Insulation requirememnts noted to "R-10+R-19FC minimum or U=0.041 Maximum".
 - c. Drawing A3.1, dated 2-21-2024; Details A15, E15, and J15; Delete insulation shown within exterior 3-5/8" metal stud. This sound attenuation blanket is not required on exterior wall as part of Partition Type 55.
- 4. Regarding Building Control Systems:
 - a. Contractor shall disregard references to programmable thermostats in the Contract Documents and shall provide the split system HVAC equipment with a Bacnet card and shall provide all labor, materials, programming and modifications to the existing CCAC control system as required to tie the new equipment into the existing HVAC management system. HVAC Control cabinet is located in the existing BLET building being expanded. For more information on the existing system contractors may contact Mr. Jerome Blackman with CCAC at (919)763-2063.

Discussion:

- John K. Farkas, AIA (JKF) of JKF Architecture provided introductions and conducted the Pre-Bid Conference. The Owner's representatives included Sammy Deans, Director of Facilities. Laura Kelly and Bill Gardner of Facilities were also present.
- 2) JKF noted this was not a Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference for Bidders.
- 3) JKF reviewed Notice to Bidders including access to Bid Documents through JKF Architecture.
- 4) JKF reviewed Form OC-15 Instructions to Bidders and General Conditions of the Contract, Supplementary Conditions including Liquidated Damage requirements.
 - a) OC-15, Article 10e, confirms requirements for permitting to be included. GC is responsible for all permits. Beaufort County Inspections is AHJ. See also 10.b for inclusion of tap and utility fees.
- 5) JKF reviewed Guidelines for Recruitment and Selection of Minority Businesses for Participation in State Construction Contracts.
 - a) Attendees were advised to review all MBE requirements and expectations as well as the proper bid documents to be submitted with Bid. All required forms are already in the specification.
 - b) Bidders shall review the Contract documents for cancellation clauses for insurance required by the State of North Carolina without exception. They are noted in the General Conditions.
 - c) The Bid Opening will be in the same room as the pre-bid, Building #10A Classroom.
- 6) JKF reviewed the Summary of Work, Section 011000. Correct the addition size noted in Paragraph 1.4.A.1 from "4,800" to "1,600".
- 7) Reviewed Allowances and Alternates.
- 8) JKF reviewed Form of Proposal. Noted Bidders must complete all information required on the forms and properly execute the document. Read the complete requirements noted on the Bid Form for Minority Participation requirements and the forms that are to be submitted. Reviewed all the MBE Forms included in the Manual. WMBE goal is 10% for the State.

- 9) JKF reviewed the Bid Bond, Form of Construction Contract draft, and Sales Tax Forms. Bid Bond must be State Form **not** AIA Bid Bond.
- 10) JKF noted this project is permitted by Beaufort County Inspections. State Construction Office will assign a monitor to the project. Contractors should be familiar with SCO project inspection procedures and requirements. Everything must be inspected by the Design Team in addition to the AHJ. Nothing gets covered up without the approval of the Architect.
- 11) No CADD files will be provided to any bidder, sub, vendor during the bid period. A basic CADD file will be provided to the contracted bidder at the appropriate time. The contractor is responsible for coordination drawings and preparation of shop drawings. No portion of the Contract Documents shall be copied and resubmitted as a shop drawing as that will be a copyright violation.
- 12) JKF noted that all questions shall be directed to his attention. E-mails are acceptable. JKF's e-mail is jkf@jkf-arch.com. All questions are to be submitted in writing. JKF requested contractors submit any and all questions to JKF no later than noon <u>Monday</u>, June 24th. The Owner is not to be contacted by any bidders during the bid period.
- 13) JKF noted there are no restrictions on working on the site except as may be required by Beaufort County Ordinances.
- 14) JKF did a brief overview of the scope and noted the following:
 - a) Construction Testing will be paid for by the Owner. All scheduling of Testing Agency will be through the Architect. The Contractor will not schedule any testing, but request through Architect.
 - b) Coordination Drawings are to be provided by the GC per Section 013100.A of the specification. If not provided, the contractor will be required to correct any coordination items in the field to the satisfaction of the Architect at no cost to the owner.
- 15) Discussed base bid duration. No objections.
- 16) A list of attendees will be attached to the minutes of this meeting and included in Addendum #1.
- 17) Substitution requests were discussed. Substitutions are to be submitted by prime bidders only. No consideration will be given to any subcontractor, vendor, or manufacturer unless it comes through the prime bidder who will review and recommend approval or disapproval. Must be received 14 days prior to bid.
- 18) Owner comments:
 - a) None.
- 19) Bidding Questions:
 - a) None.
- 20) Adjourned. Contractors can visit the site at their convenience.

MINORITY BUSINESS PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS;

<u>Provide with the bid</u> - Under GS 143-128.2(c) the undersigned bidder shall identify <u>on its bid</u> (Identification of Minority Business Participation Form) the minority businesses that it will use on the project with the total dollar value of the bids that will be performed by the minority businesses. <u>Also</u> list the good faith efforts (Affidavit A) made to solicit minority participation in the bid effort.
